



Sustainable Urban Development Conferences

Delegations of faculty in the US and China interact with counterparts through joint conferences. Participants present their knowledge and experiences in sustainable urban development from multiple disciplines, as well as information on SCI's educational model, the Sustainable City Year Program.

Visiting Scholar Program

SCI partners with Chinese universities to host a long term (3-9 months) visiting scholar. Through the program, Chinese professionals have an extended opportunity to directly engage with experts at the University of Oregon, as well as key public or private sector organizations throughout Oregon.

Professional Training

SCI translates University of Oregon's knowledge and experience on sustainable urban planning research into a Chinese context. Training occurs on site in China and in Oregon. Interested audiences include professionals from various planning and design institutes and officials from mayors' associations in China.

Research

SCI is working with the China Academy of Urban Planning and Design (CAUPD) to develop joint applied research opportunities that proactively inform sustainability approaches in China, evaluate current Chinese practice, and utilize global best practices to inform our mutual sustainability interests.

The SCI China Program extends SCI's cross-disciplinary work on sustainability research, education, and training to an engagement with Chinese professionals and leading universities.

SCI China's work includes assistance and evaluation of specific projects in China, leading sustainability workshops for Chinese professionals, developing student and faculty exchanges, and hosting joint conferences designed to share knowledge and put ideas into action.
